

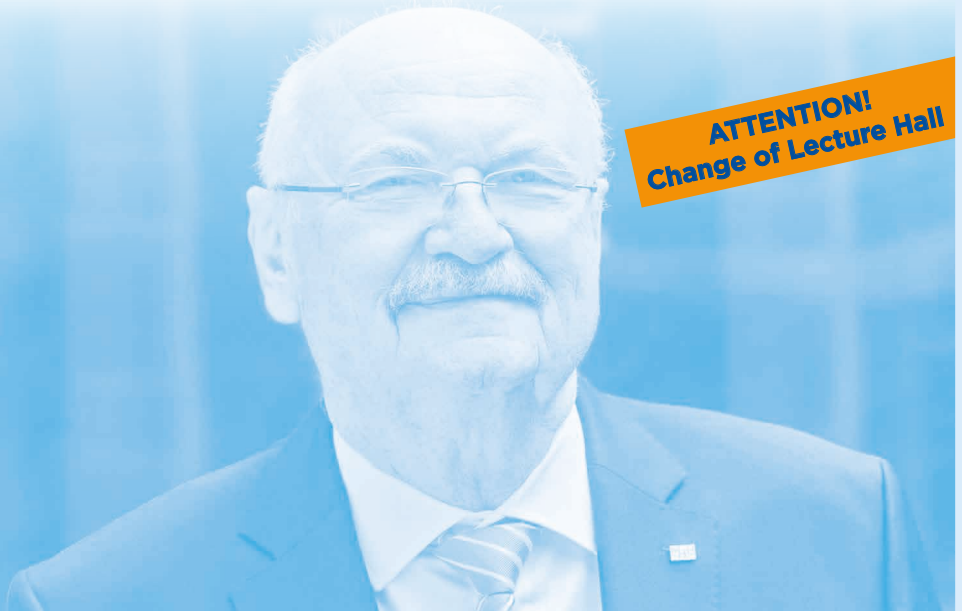

By tram from the main train station:

Tram lines U 1/2/8 (toward “Messe”); at the second stop, “Aegidientorplatz,” transfer to line U 4 direction “Roderbruch” (on the same platform, across the way); get off at “Medizinische Hochschule”; Walk to Building J1 (see map).

By car from the north, west, and east:

Take the A2 highway; at the Hannover-Buchholz interchange, turn onto the Messeschnellweg (A37) direction Messe; take the Weidetorkreisel / MHH exit, enter the roundabout, and continue towards MHH.

By car from the south:

Take the A7, turn onto the A37 (Messeschnellweg) towards the trade fair at the Hannover-Süd interchange; continue past the trade fair in northern direction; take the Weidetorkreisel / MHH exit, enter the roundabout, and keep heading towards MHH.

Joint route by car:

Exit the roundabout onto Karl-Wiechert-Allee; turn right onto Karl-Wiechert-Allee and enter Hannover Medical School campus; continue straight ahead. Building J1 is the first building on the right side.

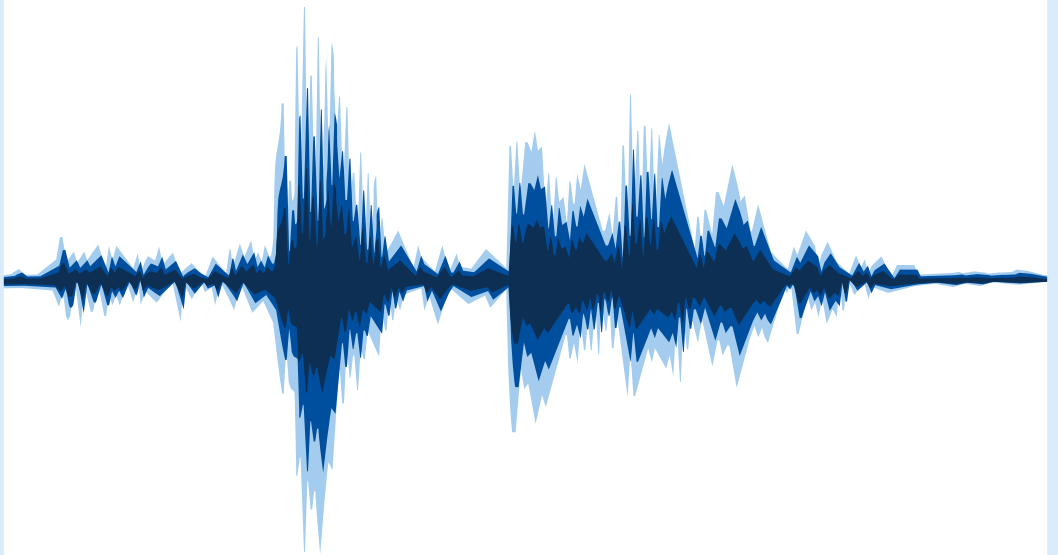
