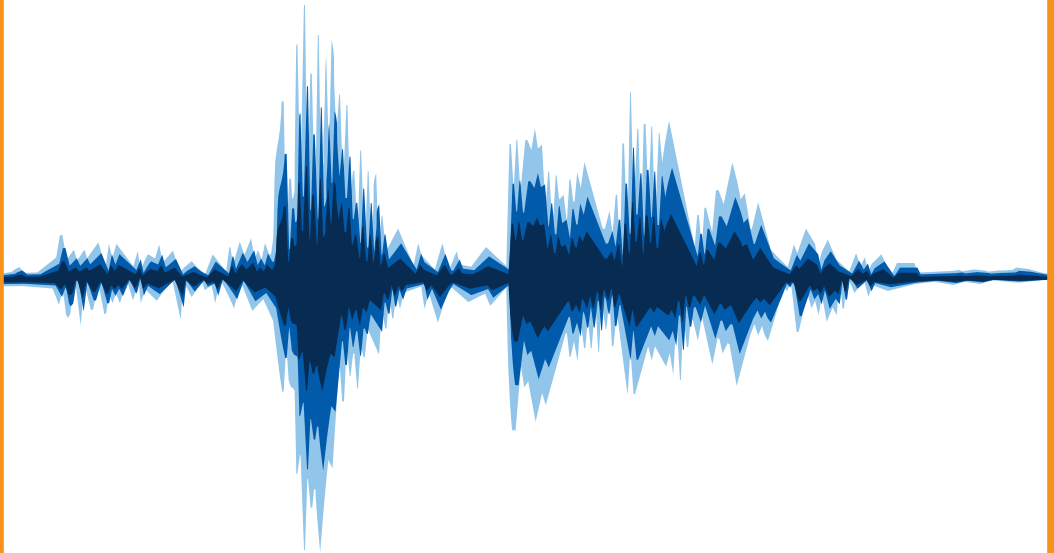
Car

The Palacio de Congresos offers a secure underground car park with 600 parking spaces, accessible directly from the venue. Additional outdoor parking areas are also available nearby. The venue is situated on Avenida de las Cortes Valencianas, one of Valencia's main access roads, providing easy access from the CV-35 motorway and the north-west of the city.

Plane

Valencia Airport (VLC) is located approximately 7 km from the Palacio de Congresos and can be reached in around 10-15 minutes by taxi. By public transport, take Metro Line 3 or 5 from the airport to Àngel Guimerà, then connect to Metro Line 1 or 2 to Beniferri station. The total journey takes approximately 30-35 minutes.
